

WSAT Premium vs. Standard for TransGrid Projects

Difference between the two types of projects TransGrid has in relation to the use of the WSAT system.

WSAT Premium*

1

Contractor companies are required to register their business and workers against TransGrid External Contractors Site.

2

Contract Administrators of companies who will soon be working on a WSAT Premium project will receive a 'Coming Soon' email from Pegasus

3

Contractor Administrators will be invited to a information webinar on how to associate their workers to the project

4

After the webinar, Contractor Administrators will receive a second email which instructs them on how to associate workers to a project site.

5

Contractor Administrators will be able to select and assign their workers with project site specific roles and order any Pegasus ID cards as required.

6

After selecting the site role (e.g. Sydney East Site Access Role) the worker will be issued with an online site induction and any other additional inductions required.

WSAT Standard**

1

Contractors will have to register their business and workers against TransGrid External Contractors Site

2

Once registration has been completed, workers will be issued with their Pegasus ID Cards by mail.

3

Workers are required to carry their Pegasus ID Cards with them at all times whilst working for TransGrid

4

TransGrid Site Representatives will be using the Pegasus ID cards to check workers authorisations

WSAT Premium vs. Standard for TransGrid Projects

Difference between the two types of projects TransGrid has in relation to the WSAT system.

WSAT Premium

The worker will need to complete the induction and provide their emergency and medical details in the online form.

8

At the completion of their online induction, the worker will be able to electronically notify a TransGrid Site Representative that they will be coming to site.

9

Worker/s will need to go to site and meet with the TransGrid Site Representative to complete their site induction sign-off and site familiarisation activities.

10

Workers will need to carry their issued Pegasus ID Card with them at all times whilst on site

11

They will use their Pegasus ID cards to register their attendance on site, by swiping in and out and will use the card for compliance checks

**For use when TransGrid is NOT the Principal Contractor
